On the 19th April, 1900, a Loan Exhibition of Historical Articles was opened by the members of the First Evangelical Congregational Church. This building of the Public Library, in which this paper is read, opened 11th June, 1904, provided a room to accommodate such articles of local interest as might be given into the charge of the library trustees. The trustees realized that the time would come when these would be too numerous for this room, but felt that in the absence of a local historical society some opportunity to accumulate and protect such articles should be provided. We will turn now to the Milton Educational Society. Founded 2d October, 1900, it changed its title to Milton Education Society during the winter of 1902-1903. One of the committees of that Society, known as the Historical Committee, and consisting...
