The testator s estate was valued at \$335,000, comprising: 1 191 shares of stock in the Canadian Pacific Railway Company, the head office of which was in the Province of Quebec, valued at \$221,377; his homestead in Ontario, valued at \$8,600; lands in Alberta, valued at \$5,000; and lands in Saskatchewan, valued at \$40,000. The remainder of his estate consisted of mortgages, cash, stocks, and cattle. By his will the testator gave to his widow his household furniture and effects.
